## SECTION I: INVITATION FOR BIDS

#### 1. Rights of Public Entity

The Office of the Prime Minister reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any bid; and
- (c) to cancel the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award.

#### 2. Preparation of Bids

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Bid Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration, and
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule in Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Invitation for Bids document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your bid. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

#### 3. Validity of Bids

The Bid validity period shall be 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

#### 4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid company Registration Certificate;
- (b) have an original valid good Standing Tax Certificate from NamRa;
- (c) have an original valid good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) have a certificate indicating SME Status
- (f) Duly complete and signed Bid-securing Declaration form.
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof; and;
- (h) Be companies specialising in rendering Information and Communications Technology Services with 100% ownership by Namibian citizens Bidders shall submit certified copies of company registration documents and identity documents of owners /shareholders to proof compliance

#### 5. Bid Securing Declaration

#### 6. Delivery

Delivery shall be 3 weeks after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period shall not be accepted.

- 6.1. The following tests and inspections will be conducted on the goods at delivery:
- 1. Ensure that the quality and Quantity of goods delivered correspond to the one stipulated in the bidding document.
  - 2. Inspection for any physical defect of the goods
  - 3. Inspection to determine if the goods comply with the specifications.

#### 9. Opening of Bids

Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at Office of the Prime Minister, Ministry of Industrialization and Trade Building, Brendan Simbwaye, Block B, 1<sup>st</sup> floor Boardroom at 11:30 on 21 November 2023.

#### 10. Evaluation of Bids

The Office of the Prime Minister shall have the right to request for clarifications during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated bid.
