# SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

## 1. Rights of Public Entity

The *Ministry of Justice and Labour Relation* reserves the right to:

- a) To split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost item where applicable
- b) To accept or reject any quotation.
- c) To cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.
- d) Reduce or increase the quantity of items where applicable.

## 2. Preparation of Quotations

## **7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations**

Quotations should be **sealed** in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name at the back of the envelope.

## **8. Submission of Quotations**

## **9. Opening of Quotations**

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Opening report stating the name of the bidders, the amount, will be available to any bidder on request within three working days after the Opening.



## **10. Evaluation of Quotations**

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared based on evaluated cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

**NB: Bids will be evaluated against the established cost estimate. Only those falling within a range of 10% below to 10% above the estimate will be considered responsive.**

## **11. Technical Compliance**

## **12. Prices and Currency of Payment**
